<b>Default Foreground/Background colors</b>	D	D

<b>Lasso tool</b> (press the key to select the tool. Hold shift and press the key to cycle through the other lasso tools)	L	L
<b>Crop tool</b>	C	C
<b>Brush tool</b>	B	B
<b>Spot Healing Brush tool</b> (press the key to select the tool. Hold shift and press the key to cycle through the other lasso tools)	J	J
<b>Rotate Canvas Tool</b>	R	R
<b>Toggle Quick Mask</b>	Q	Q
<b>Temporarily Switch to Hand Tool</b> (to drag/navigate around the image)	hold Spacebar	hold Spacebar
<b>Duplicate Layer</b>	Control + J	Command + J
<b>Merge all visible layers into new layer</b>	Control + Shift + Alt + E	Command + Shift + Option + E
<b>Merge all visible layers</b>	Control + Alt + E	Command + Option + E
